WINONA, Minn. — As if trying to figure out how to replace his leading scorer — who accounted for nearly one-third of the Saint Mary's University men's soccer team's goals a year ago — wasn't tough enough, Chris Dembiec's work load got a bit heavier. In fact, it doubled.

Dembiec, entering his second season as the SMU men's soccer coach, added "head women's soccer coach" to his title on Aug. 8, replacing Tony Guinn, who stepped down to accept the head soccer position at Western Illinois State University.

"I'm excited about the opportunity," said Dembiec, who guided the Cardinal men to a 4-12-0 record in his first year at the helm a year ago. "For me personally, it's going to mean double the training sessions, double the games — and double the headaches — but we've put together an outstanding coaching staff, which will make my life a little easier."

Replacing Mike Schmitt, on the other hand, won't be so easy. A two-time All-MIAC selection, Schmitt was the team's leader in all three offensive categories a year ago, collecting nine goals and four assists for 22 points.

And numbers like that aren't easily replaced.

"Offensively, we weren't all that deep last year, which allowed teams to key on Mike," said Dembiec, whose team was 1-9-0 when Schmitt was held without a goal last year. "This year, we will be much deeper, and, hopefully, that will open things up a bit for us on the offensive end."

"It's really tough to say how we'll be this season — with so many new guys, it's definitely going to take some time for everyone to meld together."

LAST ACTION:

The Cardinals are coming off a 4-12-0 season a year ago, while the Saints placed third at the USCAA National Tournament in Rochester Hills, Mich., en route to a school-record 15-3-3 overall mark.

LAST MEETING:

Today's game is the first-ever between Saint Mary's and Presentation.

GAME NOTES:

The Cardinals' 1-0 season-ending setback to UW-Whitewater was their eighth one-goal loss of the season a year ago. ... The loss to the Warhawks was also just the fourth time last season that SMU failed to score at least one goal. ... Mike Schmitt closed out the season as SMU's leader in goals (9) and points (22). ... After winning three of their five games, SMU managed just one win in its final 11 games, including a season-ending six-game losing streak. ... Despite its 4-12-0 record, the Cardinals were only outscored by three goals, 33-30. ... Presentation will be without USCAA All-American and UMAC Player of the Year Evan Ormand, who graduated after posting 95 saves and seven shutouts in his senior season. The Saints do return first-team All-American Collin Heupel.
